As you may have already heard, last week the [Hawaii Supreme Court denied the reconsideration motion](#) and entered judgement vacating the decision of the circuit court and intermediate court of appeals. This means that the developer at Turtle Bay Resort will now be required to conduct a full supplemental [Environmental Impact Statement](#) before moving forward with plans for massive hotel expansion on the rural property. While the court's decision is a huge victory for the community, it does not mean that the fight to Keep the Country Country is over. The developer at Turtle Bay has repeatedly fought further review of the decades-old plan and is expected to continue pushing the unsustainable agenda of mainland speculators on the residents of Oahu. The time for five hotels and one thousand additional resort condominiums at Turtle Bay Resort has come and gone. Please remain fully engaged and continue making your voice heard...we are winning!
